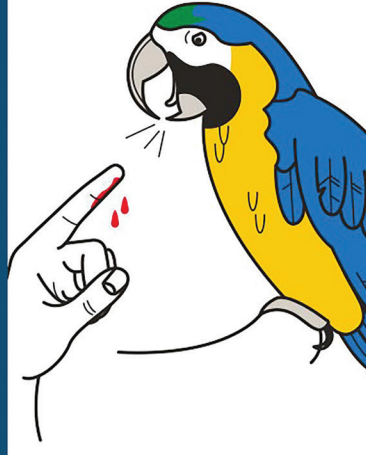

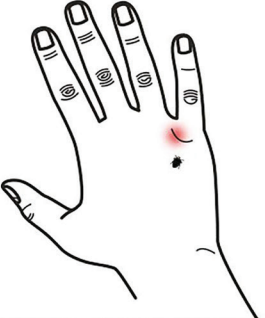

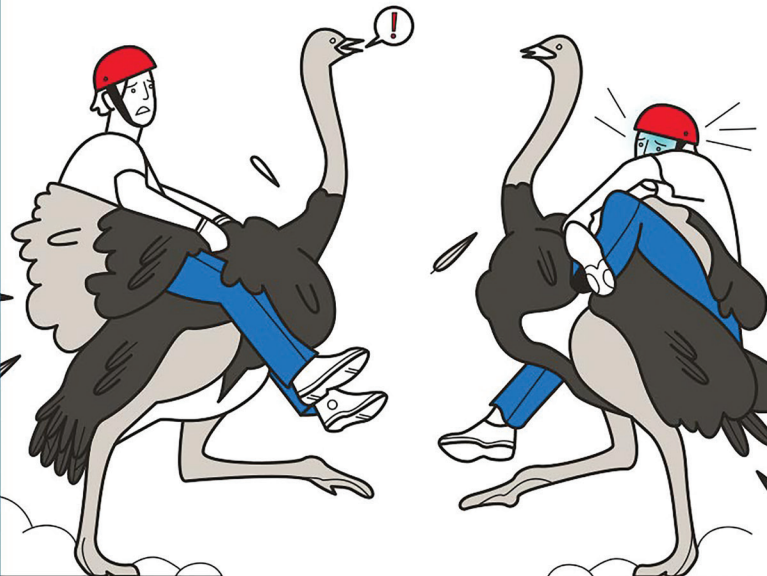

Animal-rider injured in collision with other animal being ridden, initial encounter



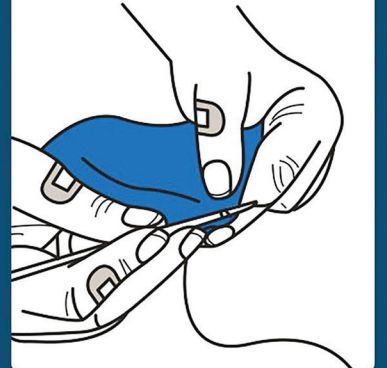
