






A change in the "climate" of technology and work

In his Sept. 27, 2017 column from the *New York Times*, the Pulitzer Prizewinning columnist Thomas Friedman writes "We are going through three simultaneous climate changes at once: the market (economy), Moore's Law (technology), and mother nature (the climate) that are impacting...the future of work."







Friedman writes:

"We're moving into a world where computers and algorithms can *analyze* (reveal previously hidden patterns); *optimize* (tell a plane which altitude to fly each mile to get the best fuel efficiency); *prophesize* (tell you when your elevator will break or what your customer is likely to buy); *customize* (tailor any product or service for you alone); and *digitize* and *automatize* more and more products and services.
